☐ Test and re-set ground fault circuit interrupters (GFI) breakers.	
☐ Dust your home thoroughly. This includes hard-to-reach places such as window casings and liquid Always work from the top of a room down, vacuuming the dust that settles on the floor.	ght fixtures
☐ Clean window treatments. Many draperies and curtains are machine washable (check the laber clean fabric shades. Wipe wooden blinds with a damp cloth; warm water mixed with a mil dishwashing liquid is safe for metal and vinyl blinds.	
☐ Clean all kitchen appliances (inside and out).

\Box Clean gutters and confirm that downspouts or splash blocks drain away from the foundation.	
☐ Inspect deck for required maintenance (if applicable).	
☐ Ensure sump pump is operating properly before the spring thaw sets in. Ensure discharge piper connected and water drains away from the foundation. Attach extension hose if needed.	oe is
☐ Open valve to outside hose connection after all danger of frost has passed. Start and adjust system.	sprinkler
☐ Check garage overhead door; tighten bolts as needed and lubricate all wheels and hinges. O should be left to the professionals	ther repairs
